


APP/Landing chart:

REMARKS:

Mountain airfield lying in the bottom of the valley. **CLOSED** with strong north wind

Landing: with wind calm or light north wind, RWY 34 (recommended)

Take-off: with wind calm or southerly valley breeze, RWY 16

Flight safety remarks:

- Mountain airfield surrounded by high terrain
- With **STRONG NORTH WIND** the airfield is **CLOSED**
- **Traffic circuit to the EAST at 500 ft AGL:** right downwind RWY 34; left downwind RWY 16.
- Heavy **turbulences on approach/departure RWY 16 around midday** during the warm season
- When taking off from RWY 16, after initial climb, turn left abeam the town of Castejón. The best updrafts can be found on the slopes exposed to the west.
- High-tension lines to the N crossing the valley very close to the slopes.
- Intense **paragliding** activity during the warm season. Paragliders may land on the meadows on both sides of the runway. In case of conflict while landing, they have right of way.
